Parents of Alleged Murder-for-Hire Victim Win Four-Year Civil Battle in Ongoing Quest to Solve Son's Murder

Wife Suspected of Having Husband Killed in Interstate Murder Conspiracy Disclaims Insurance Money After Years of Civil Litigation

Birmingham, AL – Just before Christmas nearly four years ago, William Eric Clark was lured from his Birmingham, Alabama, home to a secluded construction site near Atlanta, Georgia, where he was shot multiple times and killed.

Ever since, the victim's parents and the lawyers at Frohsin & Barger have vigilantly sought justice for the murder, which is believed to have been orchestrated by the victim's wife in order to cash in on several large life insurance policies. Two separate federal lawsuits filed in the Northern District of Alabama came to a conclusion this week after the victim's wife disclaimed her interest in the insurance policies rather than undergo further civil investigation and civil trial for the murder. Federal Judges, Inge P. Johnson and Karen O. Bowdre dismissed the civil cases with prejudice in favor of the victim's parents.

Criminal investigation and prosecution for the murder is ongoing and being handled by the Fulton County Georgia District Attorney's Cold Case Squad in cooperation with the Birmingham, Alabama Police Department and Frohsin & Barger, LLC.
